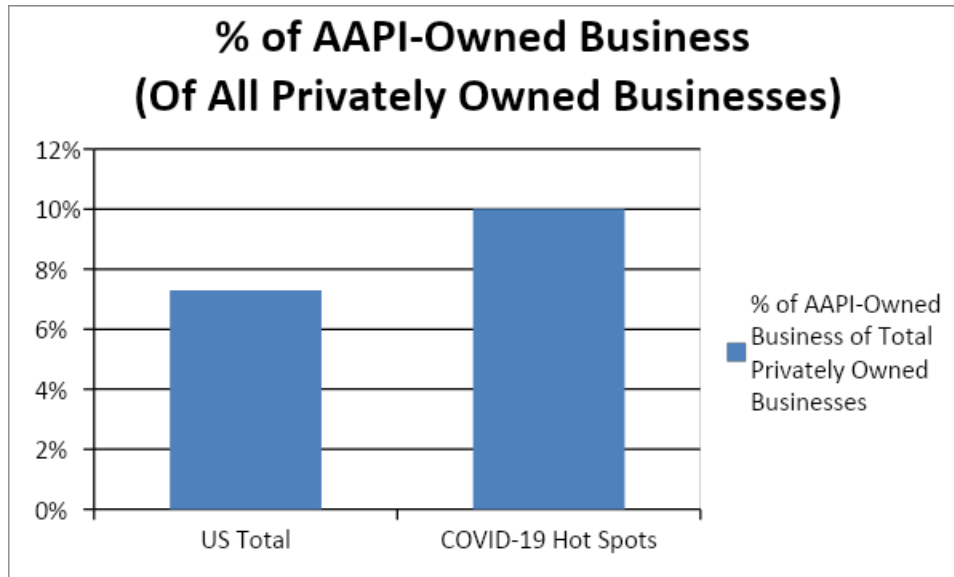


## AAPI Owned Businesses are a Significant Part of the Economy of COVID-19 Hot Spots

There are over 1.3 million AAPI-Owned Businesses in the 30 metropolitan<sup>1</sup> areas with the highest number of confirmed COVID-19 cases, including

- Over 1.3 million Asian American owned businesses;
- Approximately 24,000 Native Hawaiian and Pacific Islander owned businesses.



Business ownership data is from the 2012 Survey of Business Ownership (SBO).

The Top-30 COVID-19 Hot Spots include the following places with especially significant concentrations of AAPI owned businesses (top-10 based upon % of AAPI owned businesses):
