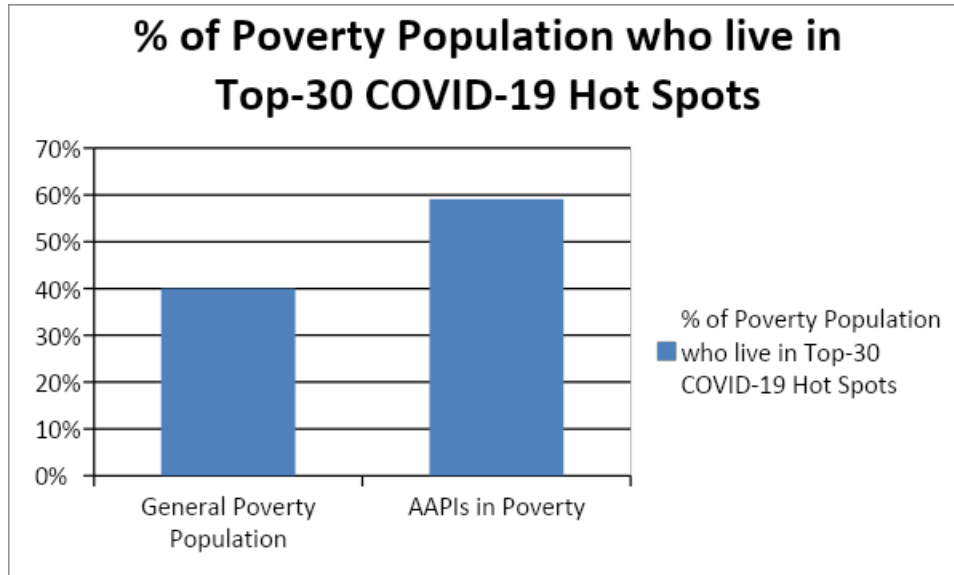


## AAPIs in Poverty are Disproportionately Concentrated in COVID-19 Hot Spots

*The majority of all AAPIs in poverty live in a COVID-19 Hot Spot*

- Over 1.2 million AAPIs in poverty live in the 30 metropolitan<sup>1</sup> areas with the highest number of confirmed COVID-19 cases;
