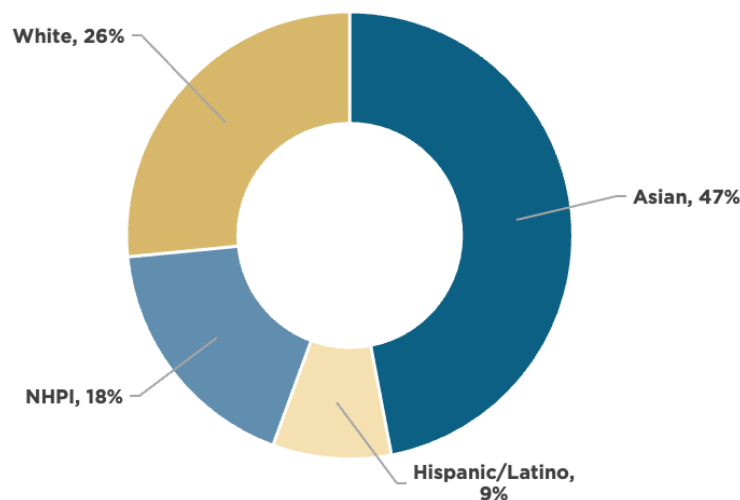

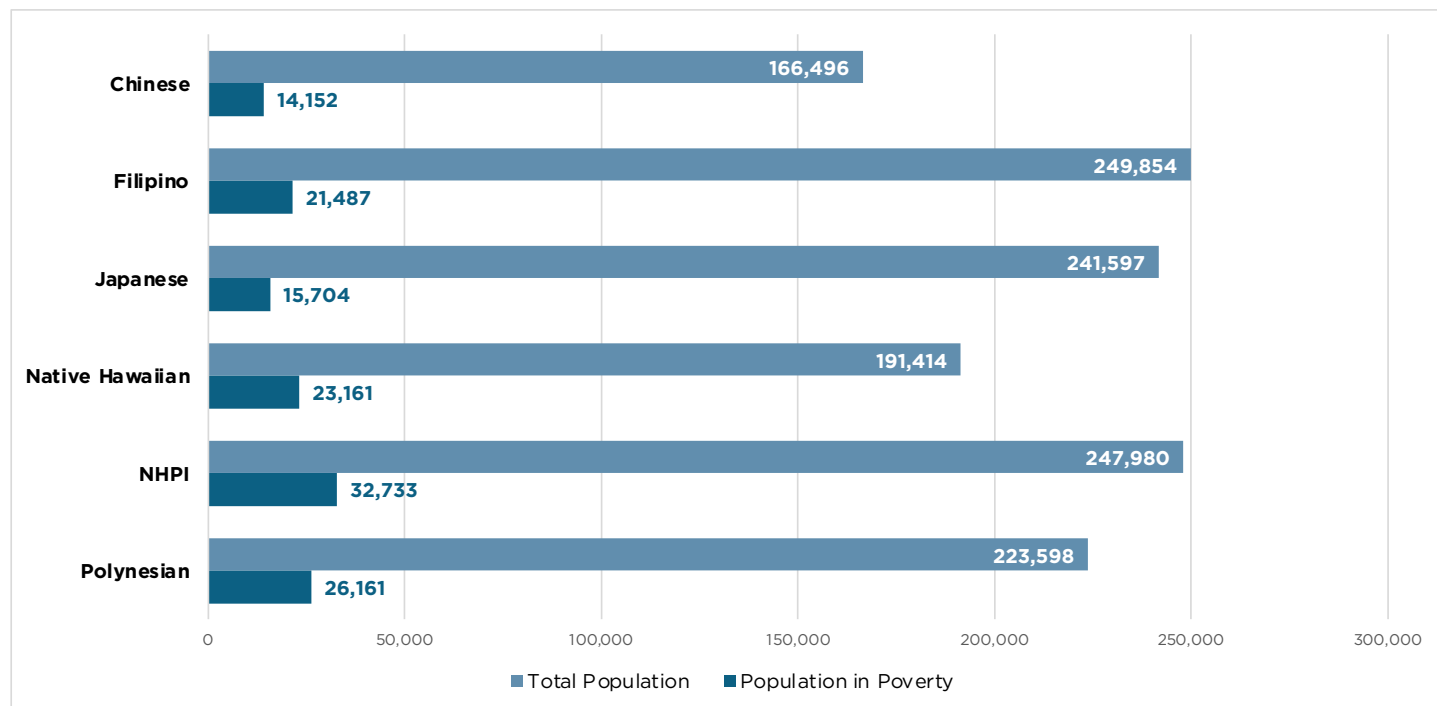

Notable Characteristics

AA & NHPI poverty rates (%) in this MSA are highest for the **broad NHPI community (13.2%)**, **Native Hawaiian (12.2%)**, and **Polynesian (11.7%)** respondents.

This MSA is home to the largest **Native Hawaiian, Sāmoan, Marshallese, Japanese, and Okinawan** communities of the 25 MSAs ranked for AA & NHPI poverty.

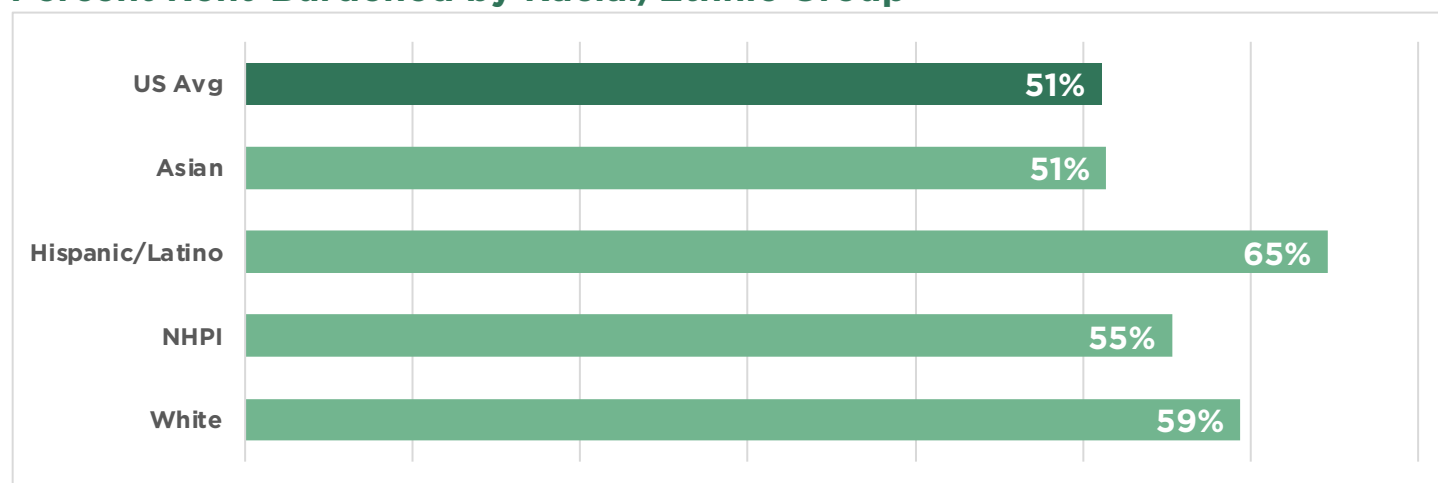
Notable Characteristics

All AA & NHPI ethnic groups indicated **higher mortgage burden** on average compared to the US average, ranging from **35.1% to 40.2%**.

All AA & NHPI ethnic groups in this MSA pay higher median gross rent on average compared to the US average, ranging from an **additional \$363 to \$556 per month**.

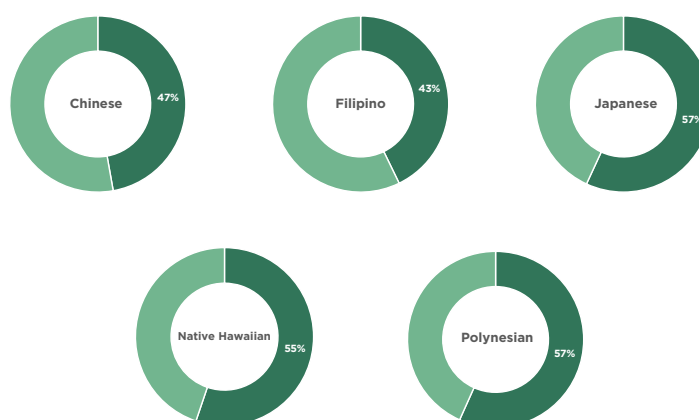
Japanese (56.9%), Native Hawaiian (55.2%), and Polynesian (56.7%) respondents indicate the highest rates of **rent burden** on average in this MSA.

Percent Rent-Burdened by Racial/Ethnic Group

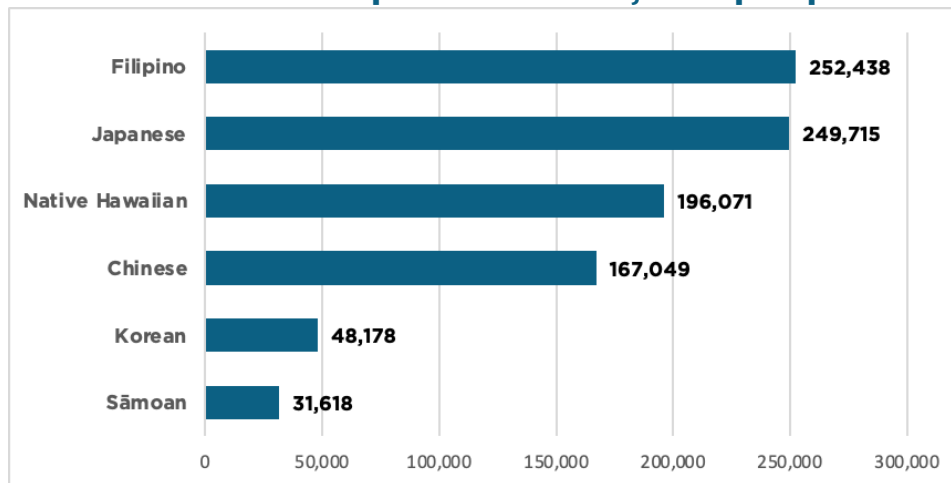


AA & NHPI Rent Burden

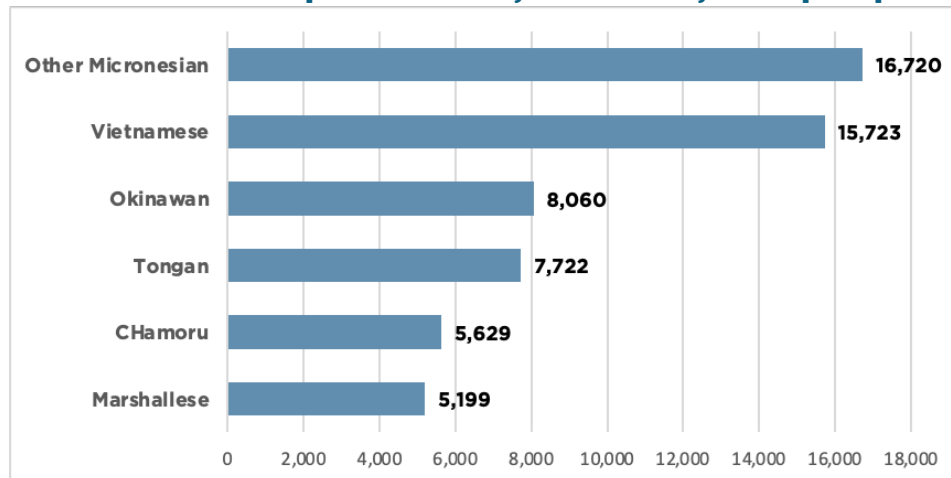
- Rent-Burdened
