



All AA & NHPI ethnic groups in this MSA pay higher median gross rent on average compared to the US average, ranging from an **additional \$211 to \$747 per month**.

Korean (44.1%) and Chinese (42.2%) respondents indicate the highest rates of **rent burden** on average in this MSA.




