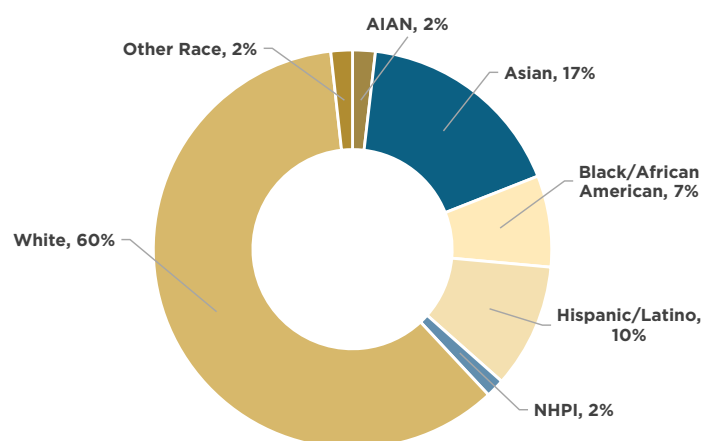

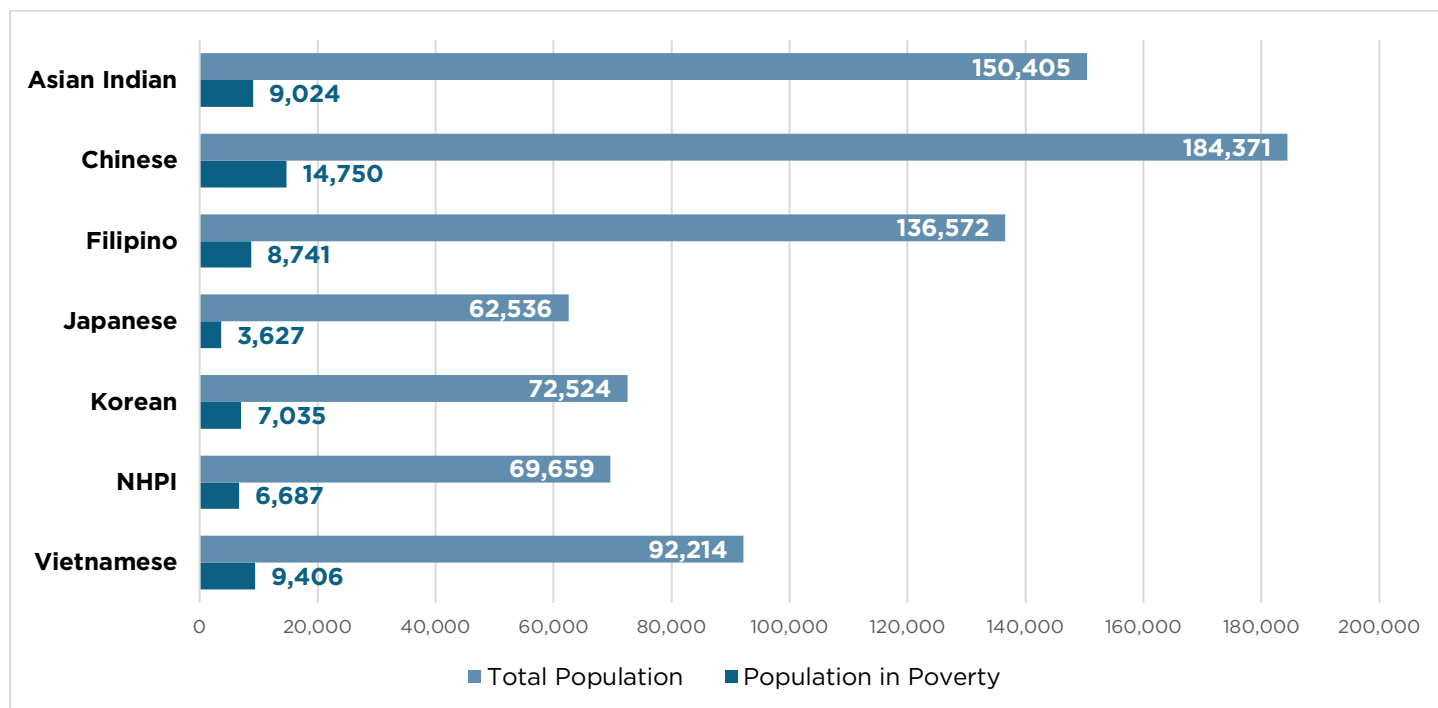

### Notable Characteristics

AA & NHPI poverty rates (%) in this MSA are highest for **Vietnamese (10.2%)** respondents.

This MSA is home to the largest **Chamoru** community of the 25 MSAs ranked for AA & NHPI poverty and the second largest **Cambodian** and **Sāmoan** communities.

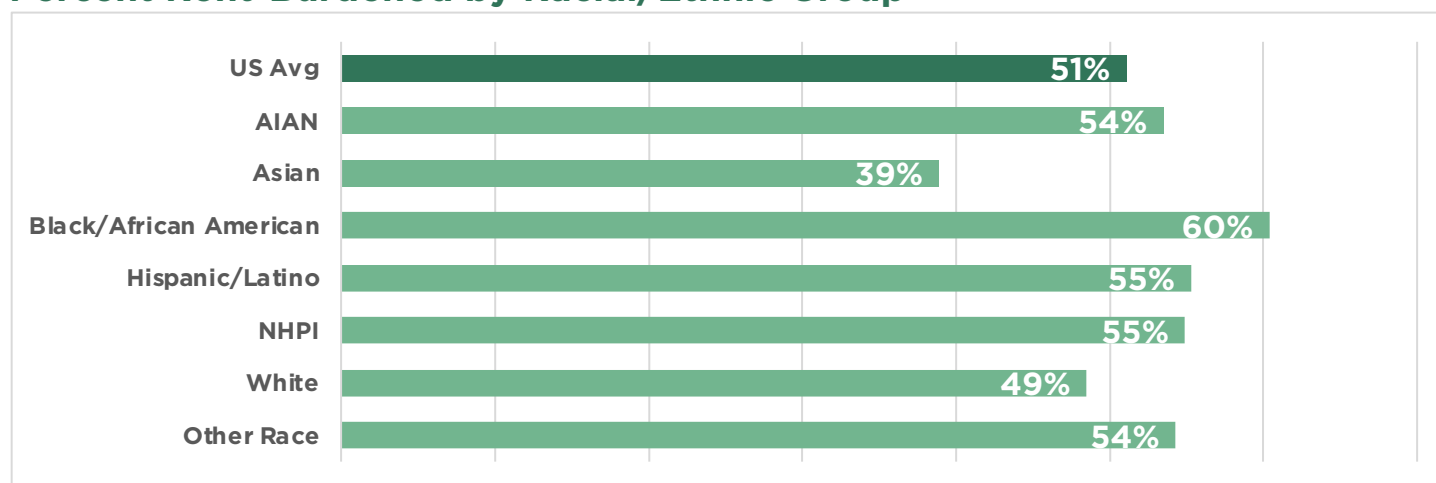
### Notable Characteristics

All AA & NHPI ethnic groups except Asian Indians indicated **higher mortgage burden** on average compared to the US average, ranging from **27.7% to 36.6%**.

All AA & NHPI ethnic groups in this MSA pay higher median gross rent on average compared to the US average, ranging from an **additional \$412 to \$912 per month**.

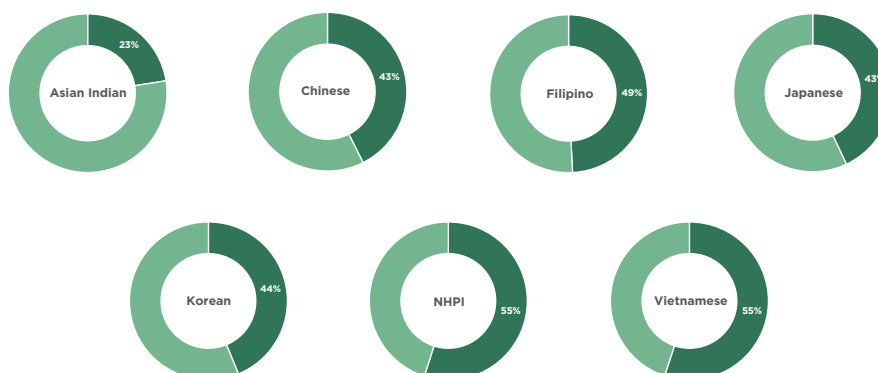
**Vietnamese (55.1%)** and **NHPI (54.9%)** respondents indicate the highest rates of **rent burden** on average in this MSA.

## Percent Rent-Burdened by Racial/Ethnic Group

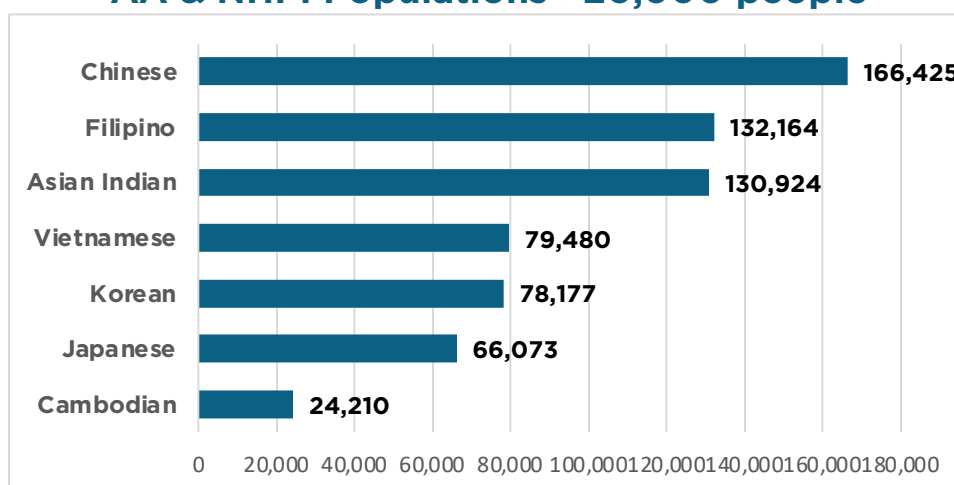


### AA & NHPI Rent Burden

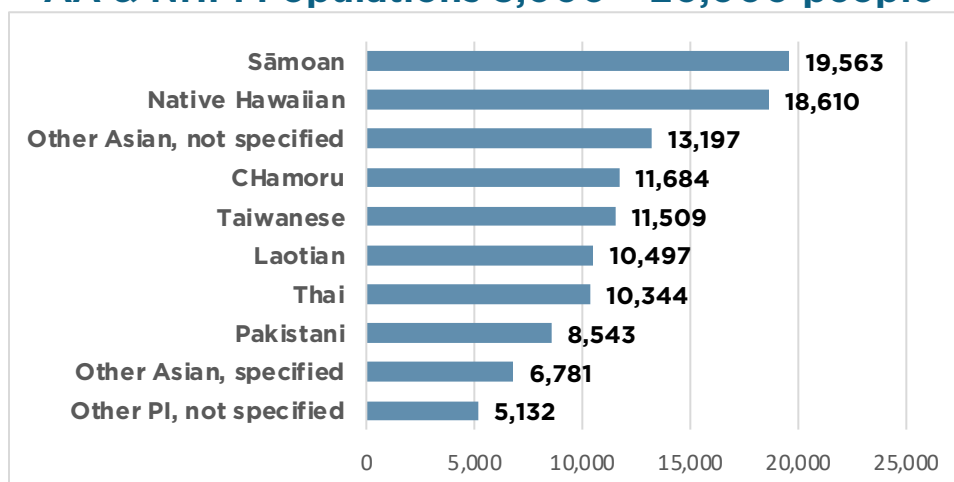
- Rent-Burdened
