


## **Notable Characteristics**

The **Chinese** and **Vietnamese** populations in this MSA indicated **higher mortgage burden** on average compared to the US average, from **32.8%** to **37.7**.

All AA & NHPI ethnic groups but Vietnamese in this MSA pay higher median gross rent on average compared to the US average, ranging from an **additional \$79 to \$209 per month**.

**Chinese** respondents indicate the highest rate of **rent burden** on average in this MSA at **52.7%**.

## Percent Rent-Burdened by Racial/Ethnic Group








#### AA & NHPI Populations >25,000 people
